



PILGRIM'S CREDENTIAL



The **Credential** certifies the status of "pilgrim." A pilgrim is someone who travels to a place of Christian worship with the intention of strengthening their faith and seeking a significant human and spiritual experience. The Credential commits the applicant to respectful behavior toward those providing hospitality and toward those encountered along the way. It allows access to "Ospitali" (hostels), reception facilities for pilgrims; it allows for discounts where an agreement exists between the business owner and the Via Romea Germanica Association. The place and date of departure, the place and date of arrival, and the stamps of the localities visited and hospitality structures are recorded in it as proof of the journey completed. It is a valid document to obtain the certificate of completion of the pilgrimage: the "Testimonium" once you reach Rome. It can only be used by those performing the pilgrimage on foot, by bicycle, or on horseback.
